Dear Colleagues,

We are the grass roots group of nurses that defeated the California Nurses Association at Saint Agnes Medical Center in May of this year. We are called Our Voice Our Choice and we have a web site at www.ourvoiceourchoice.org.

We want to encourage you in your efforts to decertify the C.N.A. union from your hospital. We have paid attention and know that you had a vote that the union did not like the results of and they have managed to get the NLRB to direct another election. We would love to share with you some of the things that we did that were successful.

We believed and then demonstrated that when RN's are educated about the California Nurses Association Union, they choose to not be represented by them. Our election results were 452 against the C.N.A. and 327 yes votes with 13 challenged ballots. The Union has filed objections to the election just as they did there. But, we are hopeful that with such a large margin voting in favor of remaining non-union that the NLRB will not do to us what it has done to you.
